TIME WELL SPENT - GLASGOW TO TARBET

- 08.25** Catch the Highland Explorer train from Glasgow Queen Street to Arrochar. Enjoy views of the distinctively-shaped Cobbler rising from the shores of Loch Long.
- 09.37** Arrive at the Arrochar & Tarbet station. Warm up for your day by strolling down the hill to the start of the Cobbler walk at the Succoth Car Park, which takes around 35 minutes.
- 10.15** Start your hike up the Cobbler and enjoy stunning views over Loch Long and the Arrochar Alps. Check out the route here: www.walkhighlands.co.uk/lochlomond/the-cobbler.shtml
- 16.15** Arrive back in Succoth car park. Why not enjoy dinner somewhere local before catching the train home?
