TIME WELL SPENT - STIRLING TO CALLANDER

- 08.30** Bus from Stirling past the Blair Drummond Safari Park and through historic Doune before arriving in Callander.
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- 10.00** Start your bike ride from the Station Road Car Park, there are lots of cafes to choose from in Callander for pre-ride snacks and coffee. The route starts in Callander and follows NCN7 out towards Invertrossachs before joining the Three Lochs Forest Drive and returns by the A821 before turning right over Gartchonzie Bridge which featured in the 1959 film The 39 Steps before re-joining NCN7 into Callander.
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- 13.00** Arrive back in Callander in time for lunch before catching your transport back to Stirling.
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- 14.30** Arrive back in Stirling with the afternoon and evening free for your next activity.
