



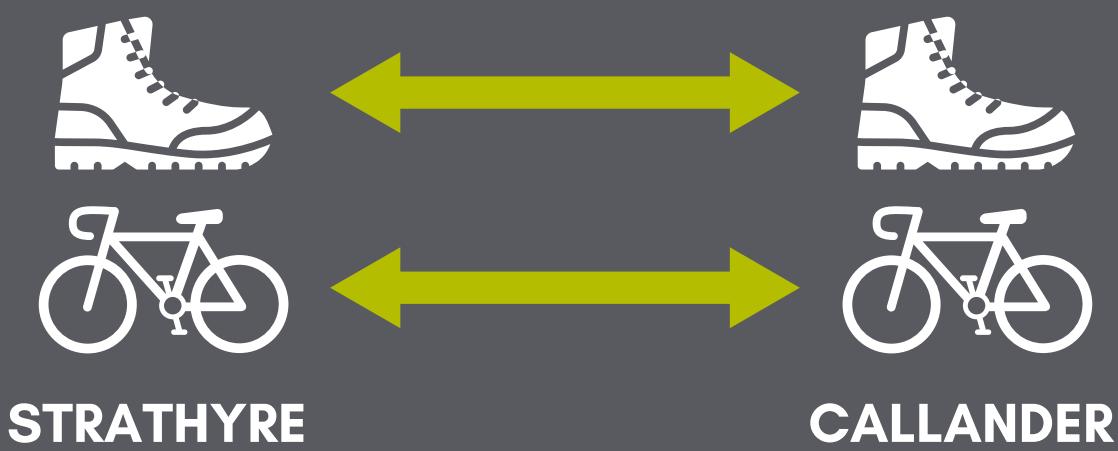

#WHEEL #WALK #CYCLE

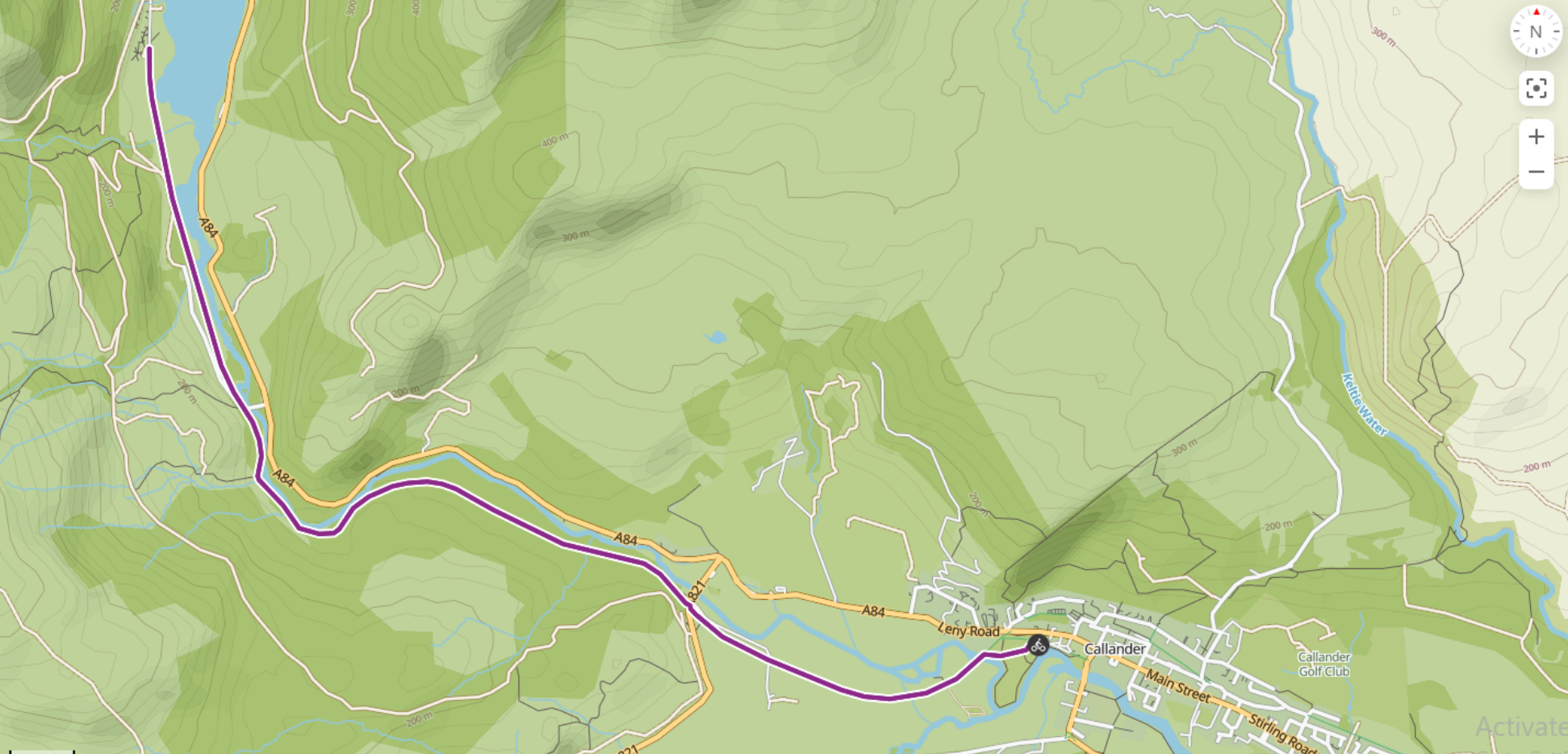

SLOW DOWN - LEAVE THE CAR BEHIND (cycle timings/**walking timings**)

11:00 **Depart Strathyre** Cabins for Kilmahog using a bike available for hire on site along the NCN7 Lochs and Glens Way. En route you will see the Leny Falls, Roman Camp and Little Leny Meadows.

11:15 **Arrive Kilmahog.** Grab a bite to eat for brunch or lunch at The Lade Inn, located on the A821 at the junction.

Family and dog friendly, offers excellent cycle facilities including a secure bike rack and repair station to look after your cycle, while you enjoy their excellent fresh food and their own real ales. Or perhaps collect a carry out from their Scottish Real Ale Shop for later in the evening.

12:30 **Depart Kilmahog** for Callander. Fully fed and watered head through to the small Trossachs town of Callander, and take time to marvel at the Roman Blocking Camp and Little Leny Meadows en-route where you will find the Hill of Kessog mound, named after one of Scotland's most important early Celtic saints.

12:35 **Arrive Callander Meadows** Once you arrive in Callander a chance to explore the local shops and places to eat.

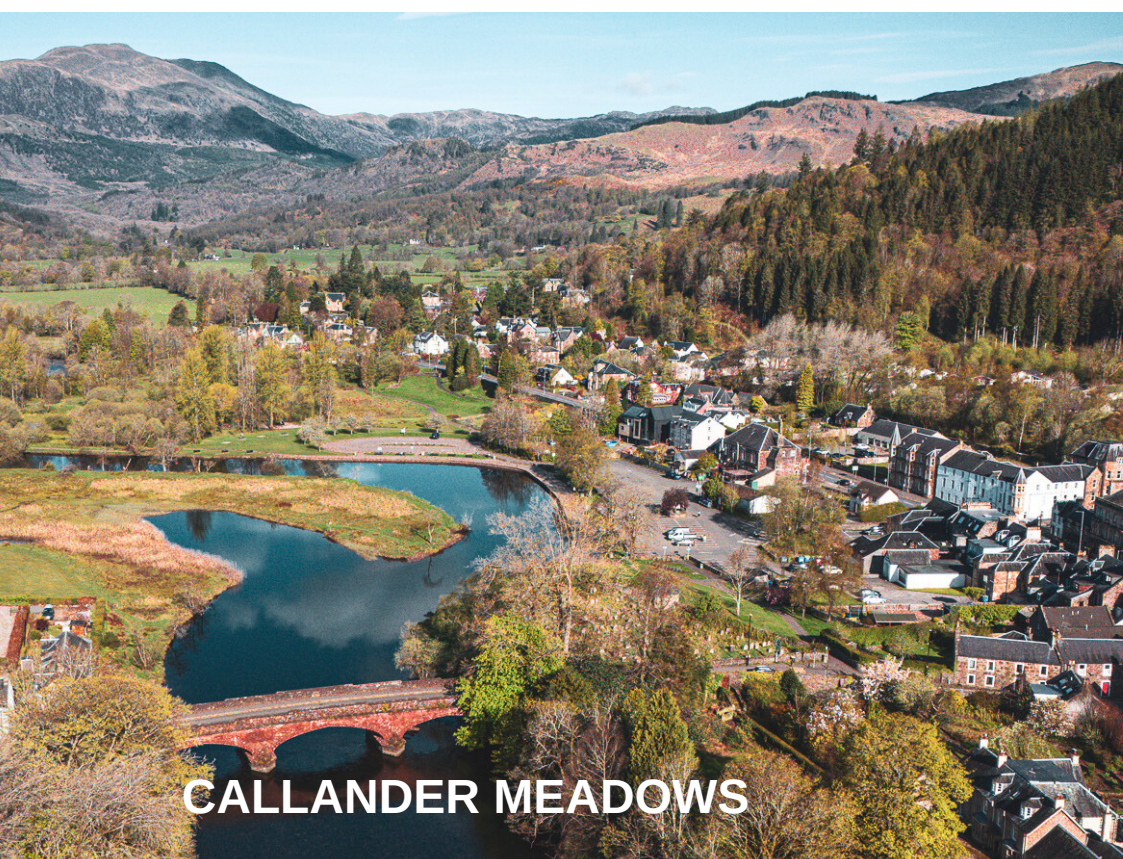
